CONSERVATION AND OUR ENVIRONMENT



Secretary of the Interior Stewart L. Udall

Secretary of the Interior Stewart L. Udall delivered the Keynote Address on "Conservation and Our Environment" to the 1964 ACSM-ASP Convention. How mapping is linked to conservation and wise development of natural resources was emphasized. Secretary Udall traced the evolution of conservation in the United States from its earlier protective concepts to the modern dynamic phase. He called on the professional photogrammetrists and map makers to respond to the "land ethic" concept which must balance an expanding economy with its need for basic natural resources and the necessity to maintain a natural environment in harmony with Society.
