Special digital processing by the Canada Centre for Remote Sensing in Ottawa resulted in the enhanced appearance of roads, bridges, docks, airport runways and taxiways, ships and other sub-pixel sized features. The processed imagery, at a scale of approximately 1:150 000, has been reduced to 1:200 000 for the cover.
