COVER PHOTO — The cover shows a color-coded, computer categorization of ice cover on the northern portion of Green Bay, produced from Landsat 1 digital data recorded on 13 February 1975. Digital processing and filming were done at the Environmental Research Institute of Michigan. In this scene seven ice types were differentiated, and it was found that thin, "over lake" cloud cover (black in the photo) could be differentiated from new or thin ice.
