COVER PHOTO — The cover is a mosaic of Landsat scenes gathered in June 1975 and January 1976. The mosaic was made by Robert L. Anderson of Spectral Data Corporation, who is a photo scientist under contract to USAID at the Regional Remote Sensing Facility, Nairobi, Kenya. The facility is a division of the Regional Center for Services in Surveying, Mapping, and Remote Sensing. The mosaic, a false color composite, shows Mt. Kenya's snow cap in the south-east, the Central Rift Valley with the Crater Highlands and Ngorongoro Crater in the center of the lower edge, and the Serengeti Plain to the west of this. Lake Victoria is visible on the western edge of the image. The mosaic was created as part of an evaluation of Landsat data in collaboration with the Global Environmental Monitoring System (GEMS) of UNEP. A 1:500,000-scale enlargement of this image was presented to Vice President George Bush on the occasion of his visit to the United Nations Environmental Programme (UNEP) Headquarters on 19 November 1982.
