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COVER PHOTOS — 1984 marks the 50th Anniversary of the founding of the American Society of Photogrammetry. The cover shows four objects representing progress in photogrammetry from the early days to the present. The photo in the upper left shows a camera specifically designed and used for surveying in 1907. In the upper right, a conventional 1:100,000-scale line map of a portion of Washington, D.C. is shown. A modern mapping satellite, Landsat 4, is depicted in the lower left. The satellite image map in the lower right shows part of the image recorded on the Thematic Mapper on Landsat 4, 2 November 1982, covering the Washington, D.C. area at the same 1:100,000-scale as the line map.
