

54th Annual Installation of Officers and Awards Meeting

1988-1989 Officers

President John J. Graham opened the 54th Installation of Officers and Awards Meeting on Wednesday, March 16, 1988 at 9:30 am. President Graham opened the meeting with a welcome and greeting to all, and then presided over the ASPRS Awards ceremony described on pages 1037-1057. The ceremony was followed by the President's Report (p. 1071). Executive Director French presented his report (p. 1072) and President Graham then recognized the outgoing Officers and Directors. G.
