
## **Executive Director's Report**

Once again we are meeting in Albuquerque. Many of the people who worked on that Fall Convention are working on this meeting, and most notably Stan Morain and Monte Urban. Our thanks must go to Director Morain and his staff.

1991 was an exciting year. We have made more payments on our mortgage and the building fund stands at \$297,000. We would like to go over \$300,000 before year end.

Financially, we had a very good year. Thanks to increased income in all programs and reduced expenses in most, we ended 1991 with a surplus of almost \$223,000 on income of \$2,101,000 and expenses of \$1,879,000.

Membership increased about 2%, with a total of 7,727 members; 6518 Active and 1209 Student. We have succeeded in building up our student membership.

The economy will impact the Society in 1992. People are losing jobs and Sustaining Members are closing their doors.

As I start my 16th year as your Executive Director, I want to report that the Society is in good shape, we have a tremendous number of opportunities. *You* can make a difference. Participate, learn, and have fun.
